MACASSAR WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS, CAPACITY EXTENSION AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE REFURBISHMENT, WESTERN CAPE

Reference is made to the above mentioned document with DEA&DP Ref Number: 16/3/3/1/A3/39/2054/24.

This Department has perused the submitted application and has the following comments:

1. The Department notes the submitted application (ref number WU27483) to this Department for the proposed activity triggering section 21 (f) (discharging waste or water containing waste into a water resource through a pipe, canal, sewer, sea outfall or other conduit). The proposed water use cannot take place until the water use authorisation has been issued.
2. Please note that no activity must take place within the 1:00 year flood line or within 500m from the boundary of any wetland. Should this be unavoidable, an authorization must be obtained from this Department before commencement of the activity.
3. No abstraction of surface or groundwater may be done, or storage of water be created without prior authorisation from this Department, unless it is Schedule 1 or Existing Lawful use as described in the National Water Act 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998)
4. No storage facility for wastewater which may detrimentally impact on a water resource be created without prior authorisation from this Department.
5. No surface, ground or storm water may be polluted as a result of activities on the site. In the event that pollution does occur, this Department must be informed immediately.
6. The person who owns, controls, occupies or uses the land in question is responsible for taking measures to prevent any occurrence of pollution to water resources.



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7. The comments issued shall not be construed as exempting the applicant from compliance with the provisions of any other applicable Act, Ordinance, Regulation or By-law.
8. All the requirements of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998) regarding water use and pollution prevention must be adhered to at all times.
9. Please note that this Department reserves the right to amend and/or add to the comments made above in the light of subsequent information received.
