Thank you for availing yourselves for the Steenbras MMP discussion.

Attached as discussed, are the maps to show which of the existing infrastructure of the wellfield pipeline and the borehole points fall within the core zone of the Kogelberg Biosphere Reserve (KBR), and/or within the buffer zone

We've also attached a spreadsheet indicating the percentage of infrastructure between the zones, and then the kmz files for easy reference as well

It's mainly to the south-west part of the pipeline (indicated with the lines) and the boreholes (indicated with the dots) that falls within the core area of the KBR

This should assist to make the final decision on whether DEA&DP will be able to go ahead with the required MMP approvals as the competent authority

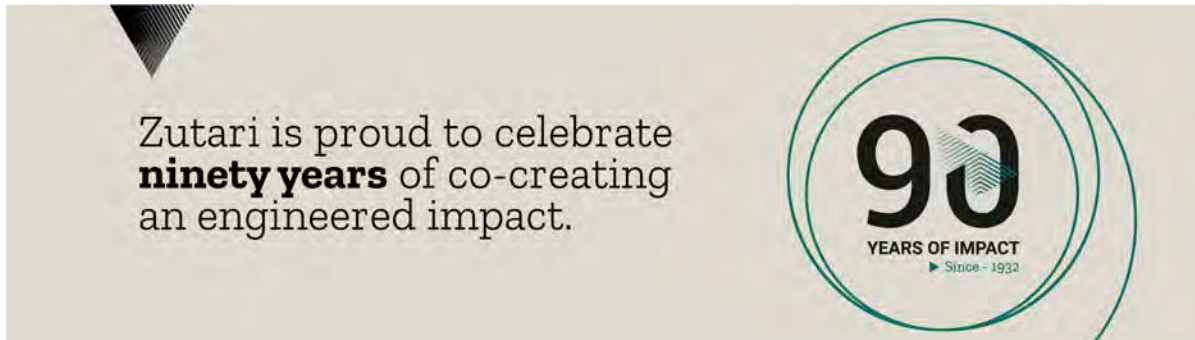
