Dear Colin

The Department determines that a pre-application meeting is not required. You may proceed to submit your application to the Department.

The draft MMP must be submitted to the EIA application.

Minimum required information to be contained in the MMP *inter alia*:

- Details of the responsible party who will implement the MMP;
- Details of the Environmental Assessment Practitioner appointed to compile the MMP (if applicable), or the details of the proponent who compiled the MMP
- Details of specialists or engineers appointed and the terms of reference of their studies to assess the needs for the maintenance work;
- Correct listed or specified activities, which will be excluded from the requirement to obtain an Environmental Authorisation, by the adoption of the MMP submitted to the CA.
- The need for the development of MMP and what it will achieve;
- The nature of the maintenance/remedial work to be undertaken;
- The impact of the maintenance/remedial work on the receiving environment;
- The MMP must distinguish between maintenance management actions and outcomes, if possible;
- Specialist input/studies (if applicable and the Declaration of Independence);
- An appropriate assessment for risk for each of the proposed types of maintenance activities and management actions;
- Layout and sensitivity maps;
- Mapped biodiversity features at the site of the proposed maintenance e.g., Critical Biodiversity Areas, Ecological Support Areas, National Freshwater Ecosystem Priority Areas, etc.; and
- Public Participation Process. This must be in line with Chapter 6 of the EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended.
